# **AUDRUVIS CHAMPIONS TOUR 2020 GENERAL INFO**

#### **QUALIFICATIONS CLASS AND HEIGHTS**

BRONZE TOUR + CHILDREN (14y.o and under) 100cm

SILVER TOUR + JUNIORS I (16y.o and under) 110cm

GOLD TOUR + JUNIORS II (18v.o and under) 120cm

DIAMOND TOUR 130cm

In the final (December 11-13th) obstacles of every tour raise 5cm.

# **QUALIFICATION POINTS IN THE STAGES ARE COUNTED**

Qalification points are counted as follows:

 $I^{st}$  place 20 points +1 //  $II^{nd}$  place 20 points -1 //  $III^{rd}$  place 20 points -2 and so on.

For example: First place will get 21 points, second place will get 19 points, third place will get 18 points and so on.

## **RESPONSIBILITY**

Equestrian sports involve inherent dangerous risks. To the greatest extent permitted by law, Organiser shall NOT be liable for any damages relating to loss of property, sickness including but not limited to COVID-19 or injury of any kind to Athletes, Owners, Support Personnel or Horses at or in connection with the Event. Damage to horses, coaches, saddles, stable attachment and other property (including stealing and loss) will not fall under responsibility of the Organiser. We recommend that the insurance would be sought individually.

#### **MAIN RULES**

- One horse can have 2 starts per day.
- If a rider has three or more horses in the same tour class he must pick two for qualifiers.
- It is allowed to collect qualification points with the same horse in different tours.
- It is allowed to collect qualification points for different riders with the same horse.
- It is mandatory to participate in the final in order to get TOP 5 qualification prize money.
- Jumping without record is allowed except in the final classes with a jump off.

#### **PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY**

In each competition 5 riders are invited to prize giving ceremony. Prize money is split for 8 places. Winner receives a cup and a blanket, all 5 horses ribbons. Additionally in Bronze, Silver and Gold Tours ceremony are invited 5 best CHILDREN, JUNIORS I or JUNIORS II group riders, they get ribbons, first three places gets cups and prizes in kind. Riders of mentioned groups should fill in their age information very carefully while sending entries via ZawodyKonne. In case age is not correct or not even filled – children, junior I or junior II groupe riders loose their chance to get into their group rankings and awards ceremony.

<u>In order to get prizes in kind and prize money - attendance in awards ceremony is a OBLIGATORY.</u>

# **VETERINARY REQUIREMENTS**

Horses should have ordered national or valid international passports. Flu vaccination should be valid in accordance with Lithuanian veterinarian requirements (according to manufacturer requirements, once a year). Blood test according Lithuanian State food and veterinary Service requirements, horse blood should be tested against 3 diseases (Equine infectious anemia, Dourine, Glanders) once per year.
