AUDRUVIS CHAMPIONS TOUR 2026 GENERAL INFO

Audruvis Champions Tour 2026 is a series of Events organized by Audruvis Sport Horses.

QUALIFICATION CLASSES AND HEIGHTS

Competition consist of open classes & four separate qualification classes:

AMATEURS	100cm - 105cm
CHILDREN	110cm - 115cm
JUNIORS	120cm - 125cm
SENIORS	135cm - 140cm

EVENTS

Tour consist of 3 Events:

1. Audruvis Outdoor Champions Tour **I stage**, 29-31 May 2026
2. Audruvis Outdoor Champions Tour **II stage**, 19-21 June 2026
3. Audruvis Outdoor Champions Tour **Final**, 10-12 July 2026

On the final podium (July 11-12) are invited Champions (1st/2nd/3rd places) of each tour and awarded as follows:

- AMATEUR Champion **300 EUR + SPONSOR PRIZES** / Vice Champion 200 EUR + sponsor prizes / 3rd place 100 EUR + sponsor prizes (sponsor will be clarified)
- CHILDREN Champion **400 EUR + SPONSOR PRIZES** / Vice Champion 300 EUR + sponsor prizes / 3rd place 200 EUR + sponsor prizes (sponsor will be clarified)
- JUNIORS Champion **500 EUR + SPONSOR PRIZES** / Vice Champion 300 EUR + sponsor prizes / 3rd place 200 EUR + sponsor prizes (sponsor will be clarified)
- SENIORS Champion **1000 EUR + SPONSOR PRIZES** / Vice Champion 700 EUR + sponsor prizes / 3rd place 500 EUR + sponsor prizes (sponsor will be clarified)

GENERAL RULES

- Rider may jump with more than one horse in each Class, but only his best results is counted for points.
- It is allowed for a rider to collect points in different Classes (only AMATEURS are not allowed to compete in CHILDREN class).
- It is allowed to collect points with the same horse in different Classes (only AMATEURS are not allowed to compete in CHILDREN class).
- It is allowed to collect points with the same horse for different riders.
- One horse can have 2 starts per day.
- Jumping training round is allowed in two cases: if rider stays in arena – after one start, if rider leaves arena – last in the current class.
- **CHANGES in the startlists – last changes can be made 30 minutes before the class and show office should be informed about cancellations of the starts as well. Uninformed changes will be charged.**
- In any unforeseen or exceptional circumstances, OC has right to amend these regulations.

DESCRIPTION OF QUALIFICATION CLASSES

- **AMATEURS** – the category for riders from age of 12 years old (in calendar year of 2026 rider should turn 12 years old). Amateur status is lost if the rider have any result in 120cm class in the 2026 season. Amateur rider cannot compete in CHILDREN category class.
- **CHILDREN** – the category for riders under 14 years old (including 14 years old, in calendar year of 2026 rider cannot turn 15 years old). Horse age should be from 6 years old.
- **JUNIORS** – the category for riders under 18 years old (including 18 years old, in calendar year of 2026 rider cannot turn 19 years old). Horse age should be from 6 years old.
- **SENIORS** – the category for riders from age 15 years old. Horse age should be from 7 years old.

QUALIFICATION POINTS REGULATIONS:

- Qualification points are collected only in qualification classes named as AMATEURS / CHILDREN / JUNIORS / SENIORS.
- During each stage AMATEURS/CHILDREN/JUNIORS may record 2 results, SENIORS may record 3 results.
- Before the FINAL event qualification standings are calculated as follows – **only two best results out of all recorded are counted, not depending if the rider competed in one stage or both stages.**

For example:

Rider A, jumped both stages and according results collected points – 21, 10, 31 and 20 – to the Final event coming with 52 points (two best results)

Rider B, jumped only first stage and according results collected points – 31 and 25 – to the Final event coming with 56 points (two best results)

- In the Final event final standings are calculated as follows:
AMATEURS/CHILDREN/JUNIORS: two best results from Ist and/or IInd stages + Final first day points + Final second day points with coefficient 2.
SENIORS: two best results from Ist and/or IInd stages + Final first and second day points + Final third day points with coefficient 2.
- **Final results of Champions Tour depend on collected points after two stages (two best results) and Final.**

Qualification points are counted as follows: Ist place 30 points +1 // IInd place 30 points -1 // IIIrd place 30 points -2 and etc.

For example: First place will get 31 points, second place will get 29 points, third place will get 28 points and etc..

FINAL

Everyone can participate in the final. Riders compete in reverse order according to points collected (rider with most points jumps last). If Rider has more than one horse in the Final competition, he must designate with which horse he will collect points. With this horse Rider will be placed in the start list according to the points.

Coefficient principle of qualification points **in the final**:

- Amateurs/Children/Juniors final Ist day qualification points coefficient is 1, IInd day (FINAL) coefficient is 2.

- Seniors final Ist and IInd day qualification points coefficient is 1, IIIrd day (FINAL) qualification points coefficient is 2.

In the Final event final standings are calculated as follows:

AMATEURS/CHILDREN/JUNIORS: two best results from Ist and/or IInd stages + Final first day points + Final second day points with coefficient 2.

SENIORS: two best results from Ist and/or IInd stages + Final first and second day points + Final third day points with coefficient 2.

Final results of Champions Tour depend on collected points after two stages and final.

In case of the same number of qualification points for two riders – final result depends on the result of the FINAL class!

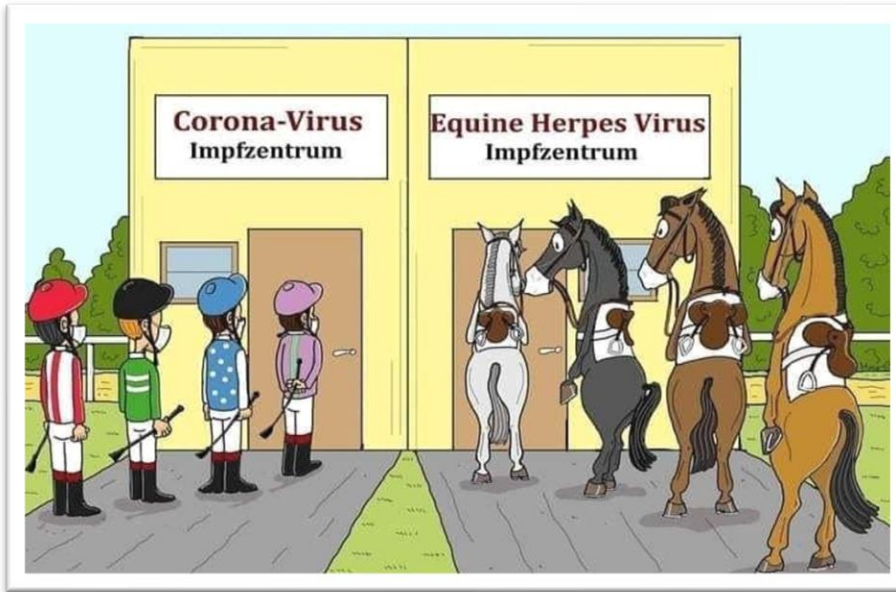

IX. VETERINARY MATTERS

GENERAL

In accordance with the FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse it is imperative that all Horses are physically fit and free from infectious disease before being allowed to compete.



PASSPORTS

All horses competing in competitions must have a valid passport (National or FEI Passport / FEI Recognition card).

VACCINATIONS AND BLOOD TEST

Flu vaccination should be valid in accordance with Lithuanian veterinarian requirements (according to manufacturer requirements, once a year). Blood test according to Lithuanian State food and veterinary Service requirements is not required from 2024/02/26.

X. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. RESPONSIBILITY

Equestrian sports involve inherent dangerous risks. To the greatest extent permitted by law, Organiser shall NOT be liable for any damages relating to loss of property, sickness including but not limited to COVID-19 or injury of any kind to Athletes, Owners, Support Personnel or Horses at or in connection with the Event. Damage to athletes, horses, coaches, saddles, stable attachment and other property (including stealing and loss) will not fall under responsibility of the Organiser. We recommend that the insurance would be sought individually.

2. INSURANCE

It is your responsibility as an Athlete/Owner/Support Personnel to ensure that you have adequate personal accident insurance in place to cover your participation at Event and in particular to insure against any personal injury or medical expenses arising from an accident, injury or illness which may occur at a show.

As an Athlete/Owner you are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by you, your employees, Support Personnel, your agents or your Horses. You are, therefore, strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance providing full coverage in relation to Events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date. The Organiser will NOT be responsible for any damage caused to third parties by you, your employees, Support Personnel, your agents or your Horses.

3. BEHAVIOUR DURING COMPETITION

The Organizer will not accept sales or offers to sell hay, shavings and straw by any other suppliers in the show ground during the show. For any illegal sales, a fine of 100 EUR per offence will be charged. Repeating offence at the Event may lead to exclusion from the Venue. Motors, quads etc. are not allowed in the stable and competition areas.

If allowed at the Event, all dogs must be leashed and affixed to a human or stationary object. Violation of this rule will incur a fine of 80 EUR per offence and, in case of a repeated offence at the Event, may lead to exclusion from the Venue.

4. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

By making an entry to the Event Athlete consents to being photographed and/or video recorded by the official Photo/Video team of the Event. Photographs and/or video recordings including images of Athlete, can be used both internally and externally to promote the Event. These images could be used in print and digital media formats including but not limited to print publications, websites, emarketing, posters, banners, advertising and social media purposes.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

The company responsible for maintaining entries website Zawodykonne.com is as well responsible for the storage and protection of data. Startlists and Results at Zawodykonne.com will include same information as requested on the entry. However, age of the Athlete, contact details, address and company details will be excluded. During the Event official Announcer will use First Name and Last Name of Athlete, Horse details including first and last name of the Owner, results and rankings well as previous accomplishments in Equestrian Sports. You have right to disagree to provide personal information requested in the Schedule. However, if you disagree to provide requested information the Entry will be declined.
